Derby Signing Families Group

At Mackworth/Morley Children's Centre, Reigate Drive, Mackworth, DE22 4EQ (in the grounds of Reigate Parks School). This group aims to provide deaf parents and carers with children under 5 (both hearing and deaf) access to a safe and welcoming environment. Parents and children have the opportunity to meet new friends, share experiences and provide mutual support. A Health Visitor comes monthly to the group with a sign language interpreter to provide a Child Health Clinic.

Learning through Play and Stay sessions

Tuesdays and Thursdays 1.00pm – 3.00pm

Come along to our sessions at Nacro Osmaston Family Project.

Have fun, sing, dance, get creative and explore along side your child.

The sessions are very informal in a relaxed child friendly environment.



Everyone is welcome to attend:

Once Upon a Time.....

An exciting group that looks at supporting your child's language and literacy development through the use of stories, songs/rhymes and associated activities. Will you see a Gruffalo or will a Tiger come from tea. Come and join us and find out.

Messy Play

Come and get **really** messy. A chance for your children to experience the sights, smells and textures of a variety of materials - such as sand, water, shredded paper, shaving foam. We suggest your child wears old clothes - you might even want to bring a change of clothes!

Stay and Play

A weekly group at various centres with lots of things to do that will develop your child's learning and social skills. The group includes a snack time with an opportunity for the children to try different, healthy foods and finishes with singing and story time.

Baby Grow

Activities designed to stimulate the senses of children up to 12 months through play. A chance for new mums to get together in a friendly, safe environment.

Active Tots

An energetic session for you and your child/ren to get active. Have fun crawling through tunnels, jump over hurdles and stretch around obstacles.
is aimed at parents with children due to start full time school in September.

Breastfeeding Club

An informal group for breastfeeding mums and expectant mums who are planning to breastfeed. With advice and guidance from a member of the health team. Some groups also have peer support from other mums who have experienced breastfeeding first hand.

Speech and Language Drop-In Sessions

If you have any concerns or If you have been unable to attend your child's Speech and Language check please feel free and call into one of our drop in sessions for advice , support and guidance.

Behaviour Management

Guidance and strategies for parents and carers of children from 2 years to provide support in dealing with their child's challenging behaviour.

Understanding Boys Play

A series of workshops that look at the way boys play, learn and explore their world and the differences in the ways boys and girls play. With ideas for you to use at home.

Story Sacks with Family Learning

Make your own Story Sack - resources and ideas to help you share stories with your child and support their communication and language.

Antenatal Session– Feeding My Baby

Are you Pregnant? Would you like to know more about feeding your baby? Come along to the Feeding my Baby session to find out about growth spurts, cluster feeds and how responsive feeding can help your baby's brain development.

Teatime Club

An opportunity for you and your child to prepare and eat healthy food together. To promote healthy eating within your family.

Job Club with Liz Annetts.

Support and advice to help you get back into the world of work.

ESOL

This course is designed for parents and children whose first language may not be English. There will be the opportunity to take part in activities to help you with practical situations such as school, shops doctors and food.

Healthy Eating

Come along to our 3 week healthy eating sessions where you can prepare a healthy lunch with your child/ren to take home and enjoy.



Groups needing a referral:

Peep Learning Together Programme

Recognising that they are their child's first educator, Peep is a group which supports parents to feel more confident and make the most of their child's learning opportunities. Work towards a nationally recognised qualification at entry level 1 or 2, which you can use to gain access to learning opportunities and courses in the future.

Baby Massage

A five week course showing parents the techniques for massaging their baby. Massage is soothing and calming for baby and parent and can help with bonding. Massage could also help babies who suffer from colic.

Freedom Programme

Freedom is a confidential course for women who have experienced domestic abuse. The course is for women who want to learn about the realities of domestic abuse, and understand its effects on children. It helps women gain self esteem and the confidence to improve the quality of their lives. Please ask to speak to a Family Visitor in confidence.

Learning to Listen

A group where children who have an identified speech and language delay can develop their language through activities and play. By referral only.

Explorers Support Group

A support group for families with children under 5 years awaiting a diagnoses from a paediatrician. A 6 week programme offering practical advice to parents and child throughout their journey. Referral only by Health professional, Self or Family Visitor.

Food Bank

Run by local churches we offer short term support through food parcels for families in need. By referral only. Ask about financial advice. Debt, benefits and cooking on a budget.

After School Buddies

Afterschool activities for children up to 8 years and their parents to spend fun quality time together.

Child Health Clinics

Run by local health teams at various Centres and at other venues in the local area. An opportunity to get your child weighed and discuss any concerns you might have with a member of the health team. Some sessions also have a Family Visitor to support and discuss Children's Centre activities.
