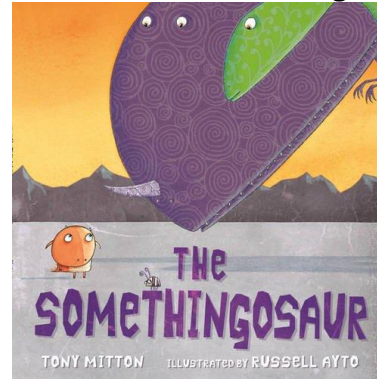

Share family photographs and look at similarities making links to the dragon looking for its mummy amongst different types of creatures. Melt chocolate and observe changes. Make chocolate nests.



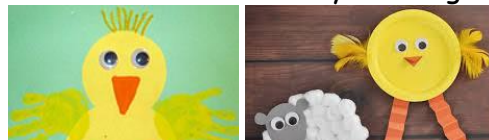
Foundation Stage 1

Ideas on how to help your child:

- Make chocolate rice krispies with them and talk about what is happening as chocolate is melted.
- Read books daily with your child and talk about the story.

Funky finger activities (Fine motor)
