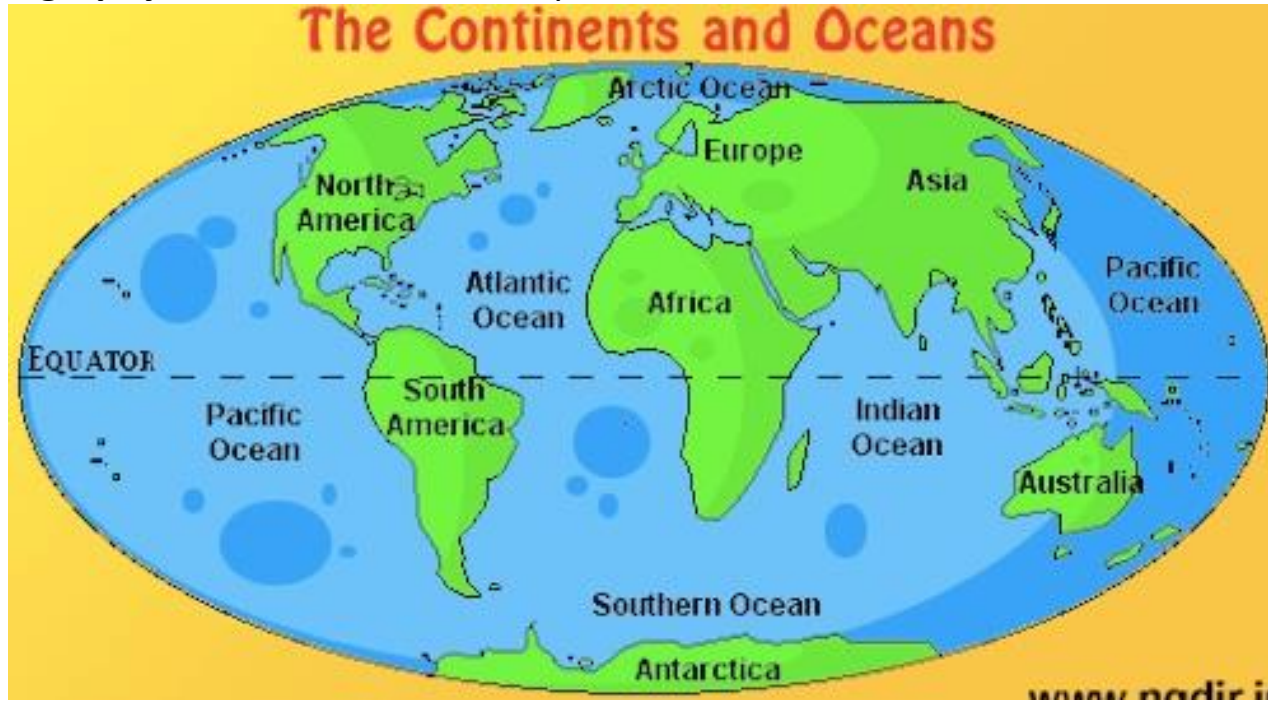


**On Safari with David Attenborough Topic – Spring 2 and Summer 1 2018**

**Geography** - The world is made up of 7 continents and oceans



**Science** - Animals live in different habitats. There are different types of animals.

**Rainforest**

A dense, warm and wet forest



**Desert**

Very dry, can be hot or cold



**Arctic**

A cold area at the top of the Earth

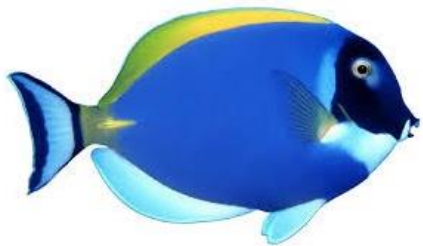


**Marine**

Oceans and seas, the water is salty.



**Fish** – live in water, have gills, scales, fins and tails



**Amphibians** – can live in water or on land, backbone, webbed feet



**Reptiles** – cold blood, scaly skin



**Birds** – wings, beaks, claws, feathers



**Mammals** – have hair or fur, warm blood



How to help your child: Look in atlases and travel brochures and find countries you or family members have visited. Talk about which continent the countries you have visited are in. Look at songs on You tube to help your child remember the continents, we will be learning The 7 continents by Hopscotch. Talk about the features of the different animals and how you would care for them.

**Recycling:** turning rubbish into something we can reuse

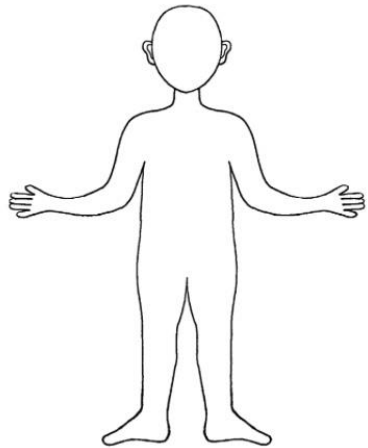
**Reducing:** use less, buy less, turn off lights, turn off the tap or have shorter showers
