Can we make models of these buildings and explore different ways to fix materials together.

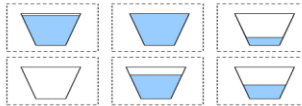


The Three Little Pigs story explores buildings and constructions with a wide range of objects, selecting appropriate resources and adapting their work as necessary.
