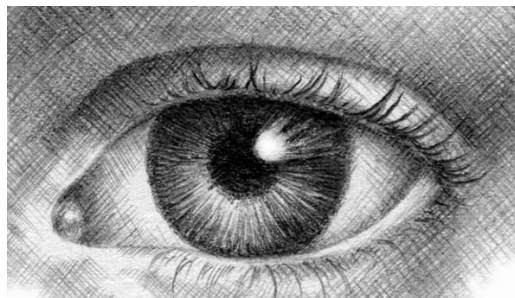


## Knowledge Organiser- Year 3 Life Drawing

### Technical Terms:
