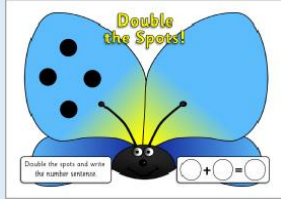
The children at Osmaston Primary School have been busy this month . . .
